



PUSH is a local, not-for-profit organization that provides assistance for essential repairs to eligible homeowners who, without such assistance, would be unable to make the repairs necessary for them to remain in their homes. Anyone who has been concerned about problems in their home and has not been able to obtain the necessary funds, should consider making an application to PUSH.

Often representatives inspect project sites prior to the review by the PUSH Board. All homes being worked on will need to be in good sanitary condition, free of debris to ensure the safe working conditions for the contractors hired to complete the job. Applicants will also need to ensure that all pets are secured away from the job area. Call 513-523-5859 for more information.

If you are a low-income homeowner living within the Talawanda School District, you may be eligible for assistance with emergency or critical repairs to your home.

If the cost of the repairs is more than \$500, project approval must wait until the next PUSH board meeting.

*The homeowner is responsible for the health and safety conditions of the home and PUSH Board members will determine that the work space is clean and free of debris before a work order is issued. All pets will need to be secured away from the work area.
